Children born in Lesotho faces staggering challenges from the day they are born – poverty, malnutrition, sky-high HIV rates. Babies fortunate enough to be born in hospitals need hats to help them retain body heat all year long but especially in the winter. ***Hospitals in Lesotho have asked for our help by providing knit caps for children from newborn to age two.***

The **Yarn Sellar**, in partnership with **SHARED**, a U.S. not-for-profit organization, asks you to help these children by getting out your knitting needles and making baby caps. The **Yarn Sellar** is providing a **choice of free patterns** and has a lovely selection of yarns to make a baby cap, which usually requires one skein of yarn.

All finished baby caps can be dropped off at the **Yarn Sellar** and Martha McAfee will coordinate their delivery to **SHARED**. **SHARED** will get the caps to the grateful hospitals in Lesotho.
